SHOP & DROP POP-UPS

One of the founding principles of Vintage Thrivals is the practice of sustainability. Which created the SHOP and DROP initative! A pop up shop where patrons can shop the latest from Vintage Thrivals as well as donate unwanted clothing!

With the SHOP and DROP intiative, we plan to create a new ecosystem within the community. Our aim to see less clothing going to landfills, or being blindly donated to centers, where we don't get to see the direct impact. The items donated during the SHOP and DROP will be sorted, and what is not used to create new pieces for Vintage Thrivals will be donated directly to community impact entities and resource groups to make sure that items are getting to the persons who need them.

Our projection is to create quaterly SHOP and DROP pop ups throughout the year, partnering with local business to also stimulate their spaces. To activate the partnering businesses we also offer discounts to patrons who make purchases with the partnering venue/business. We are aiming to reduce the waste created by clothing in landfills, raise community awareness, and continue to keep fashion fun, and accessible to all people.

DINNER WITH DESIGNERS

Dinner with Designers is a traveling event series created by the minds inside Vintage Thrivals. This experience celebrates the work of regionally based designers, and culinary creators. A merger of the fine arts that comprise food and fashion are sure to entice any enthusiast of either medium.

We would love to contnue to expand the legacy of Dinner with Designers by bringing this experience to your city!


